CITY OF HONDO OVERALL PROPOSED SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PLAN

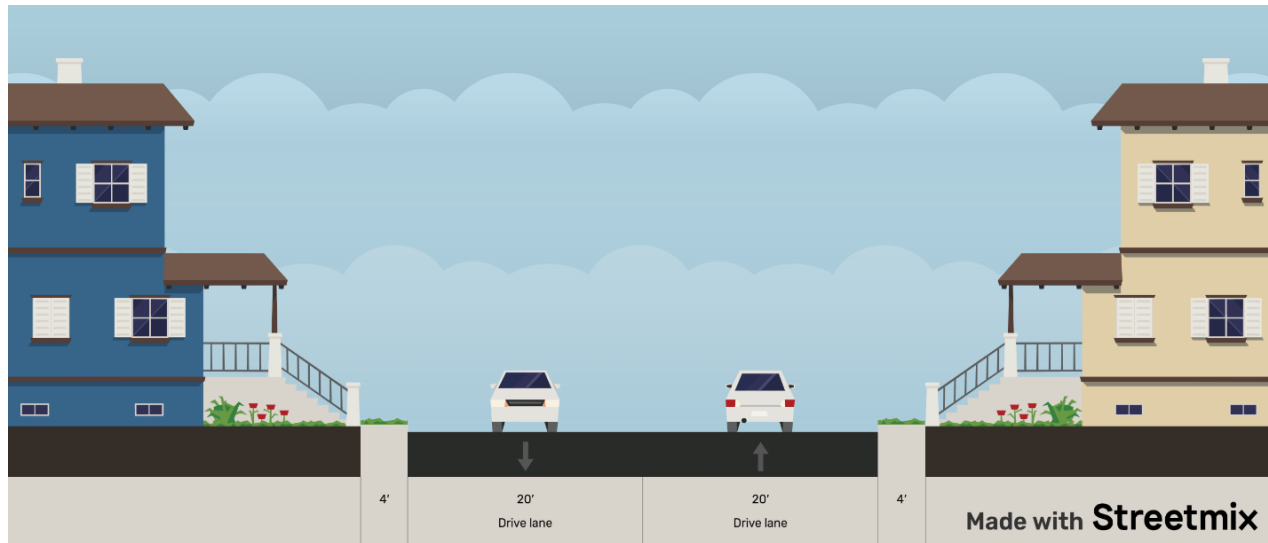


AVE U PROPOSED SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

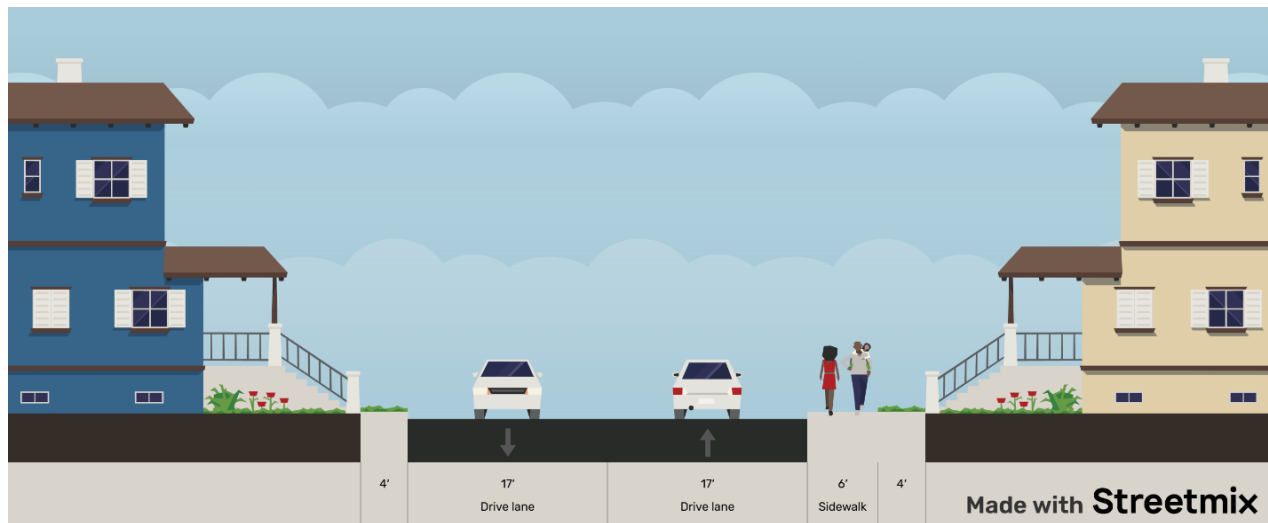


AVE U TYPICAL SECTION

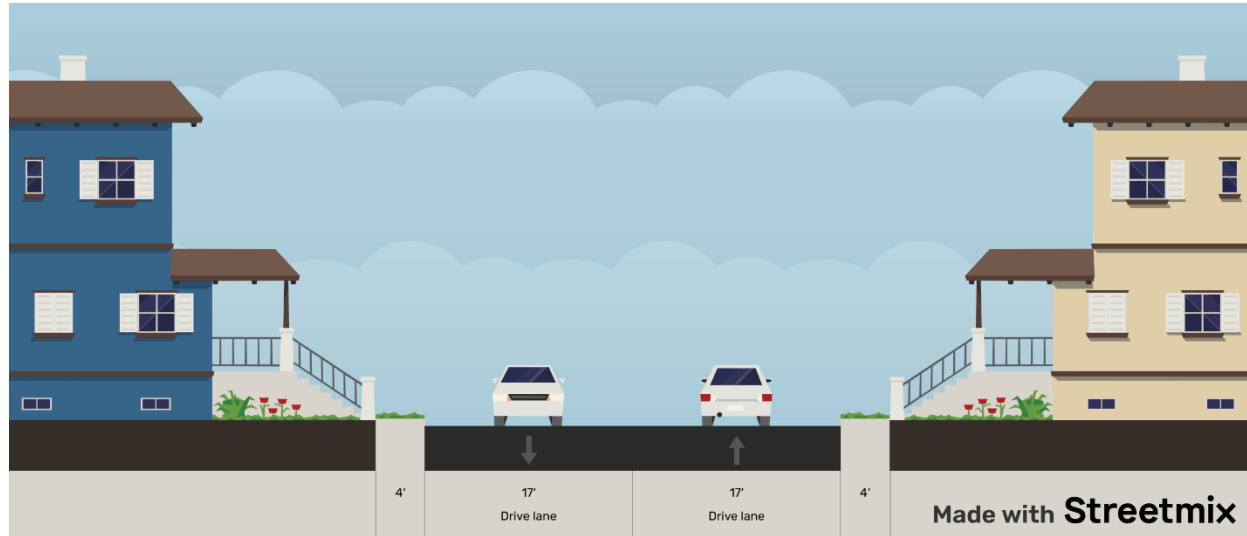


AVE Q PROPOSED SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

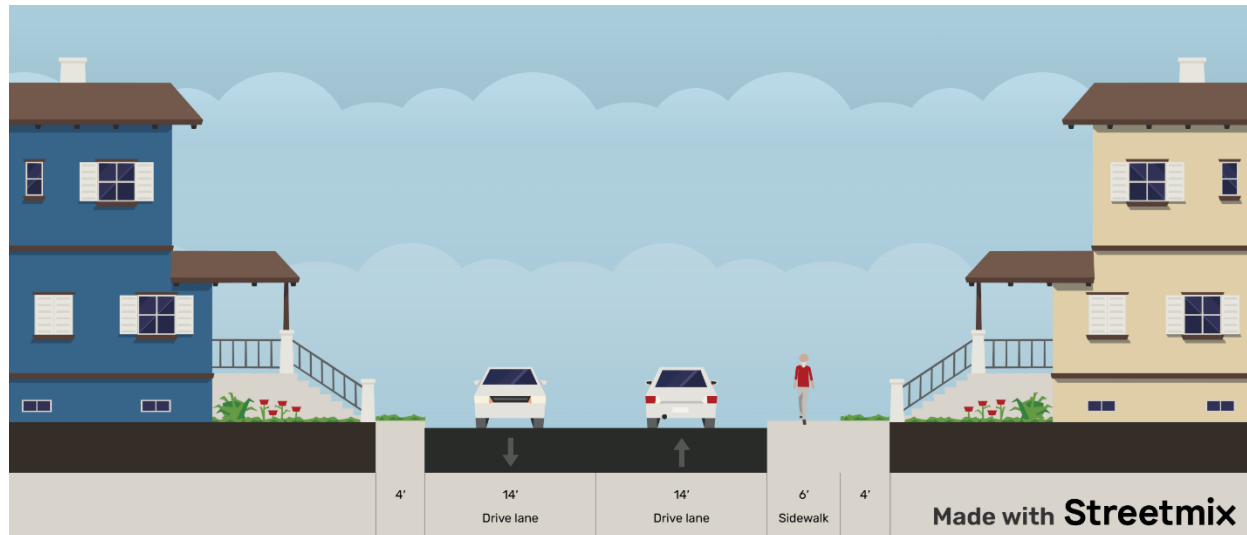


AVE Q TYPICAL SECTION

30th ST To Hwy 90 (19th St)

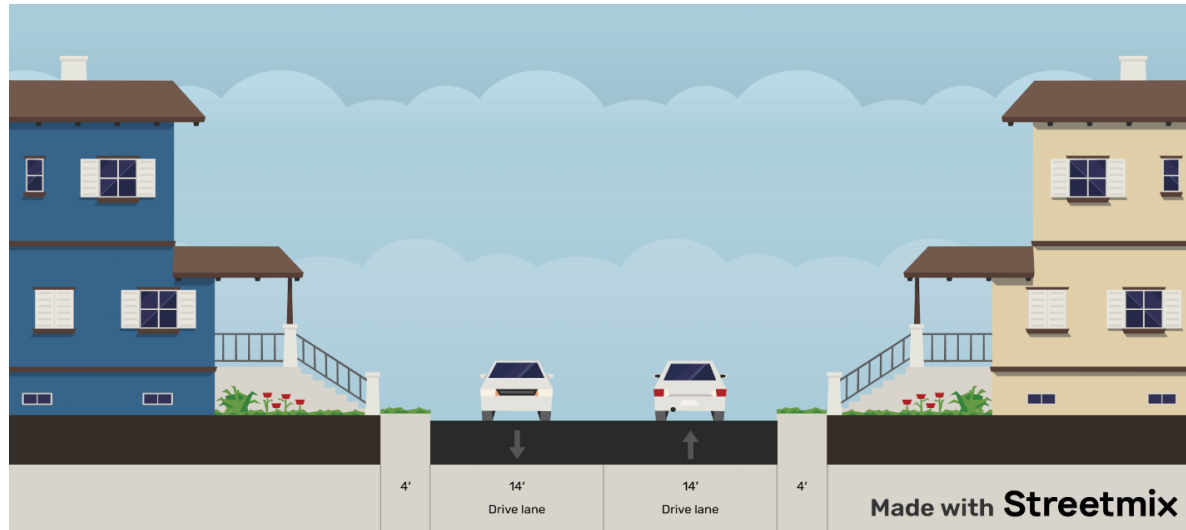


22ND ST PROPOSED SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

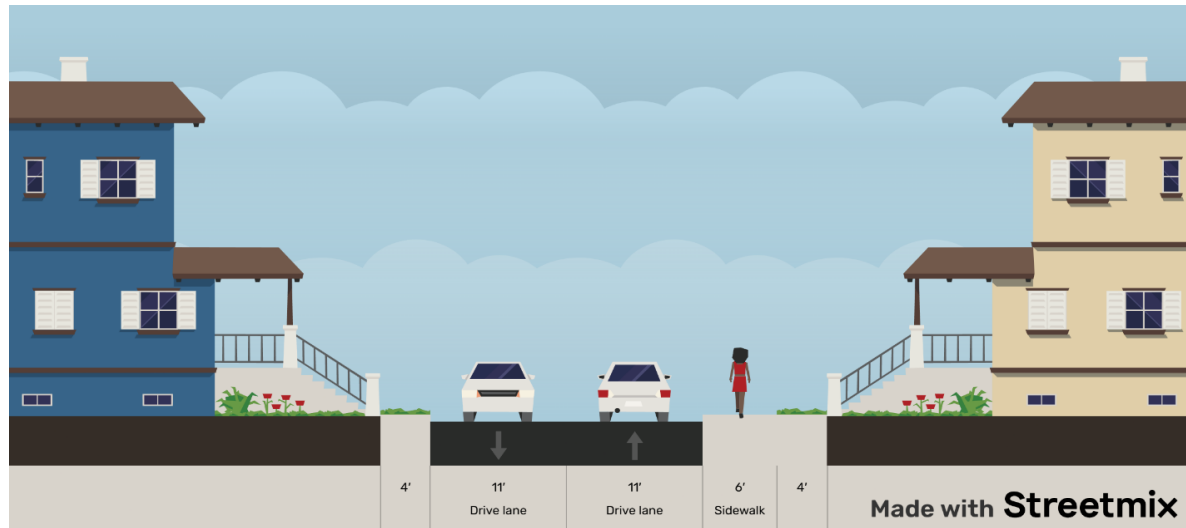


22ND ST TYPICAL SECTION

Avenue U To Avenue M

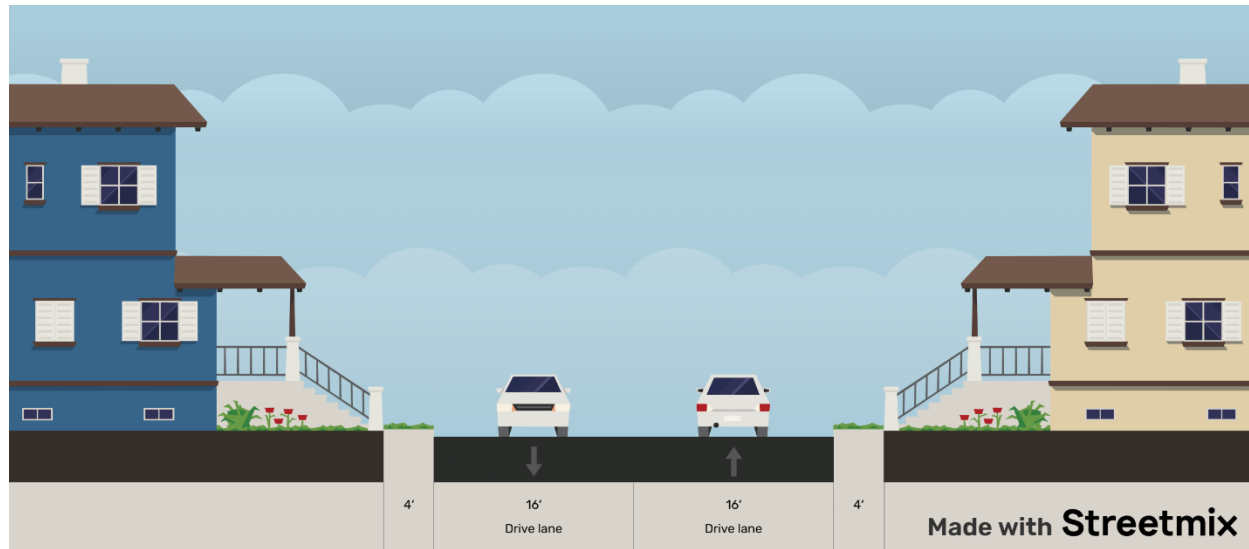


24TH ST PROPOSED SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

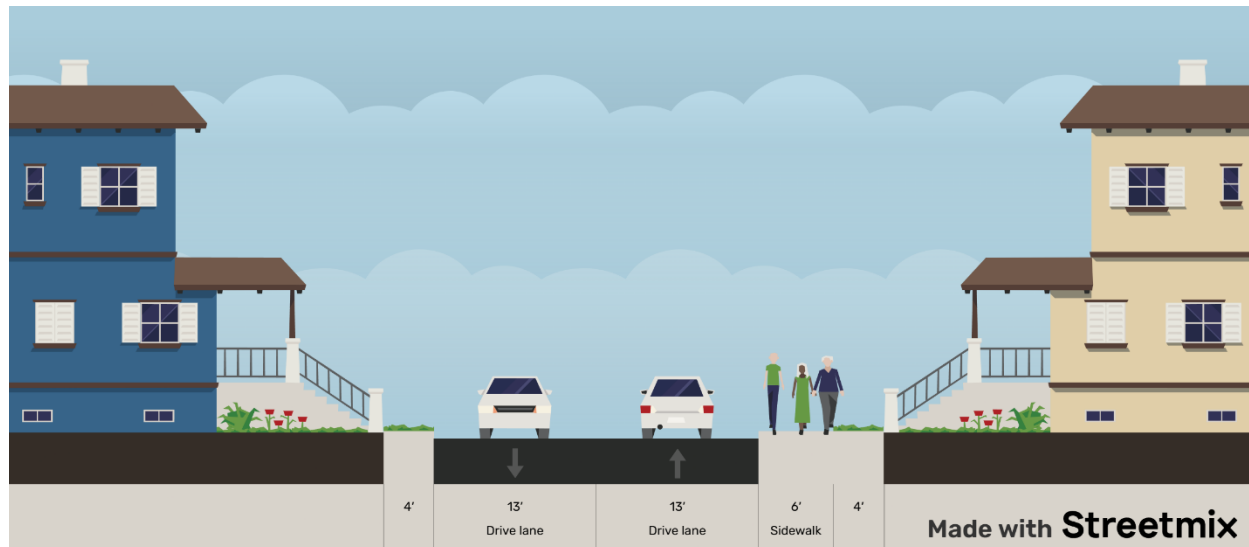


24TH ST TYPICAL SECTION

Avenue U To Avenue Q

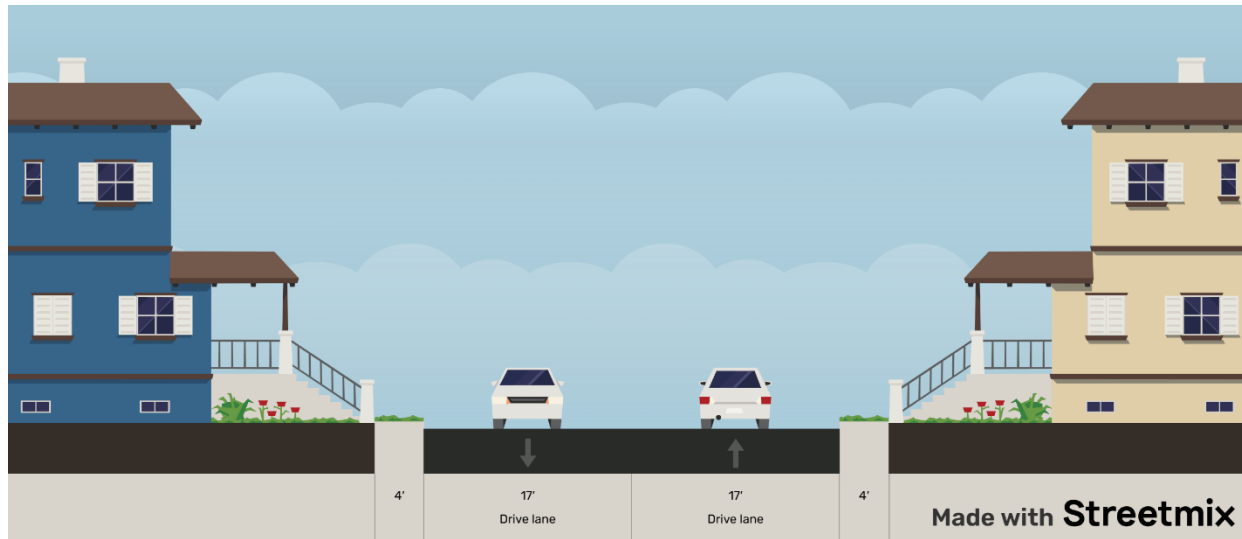


27TH ST PROPOSED SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

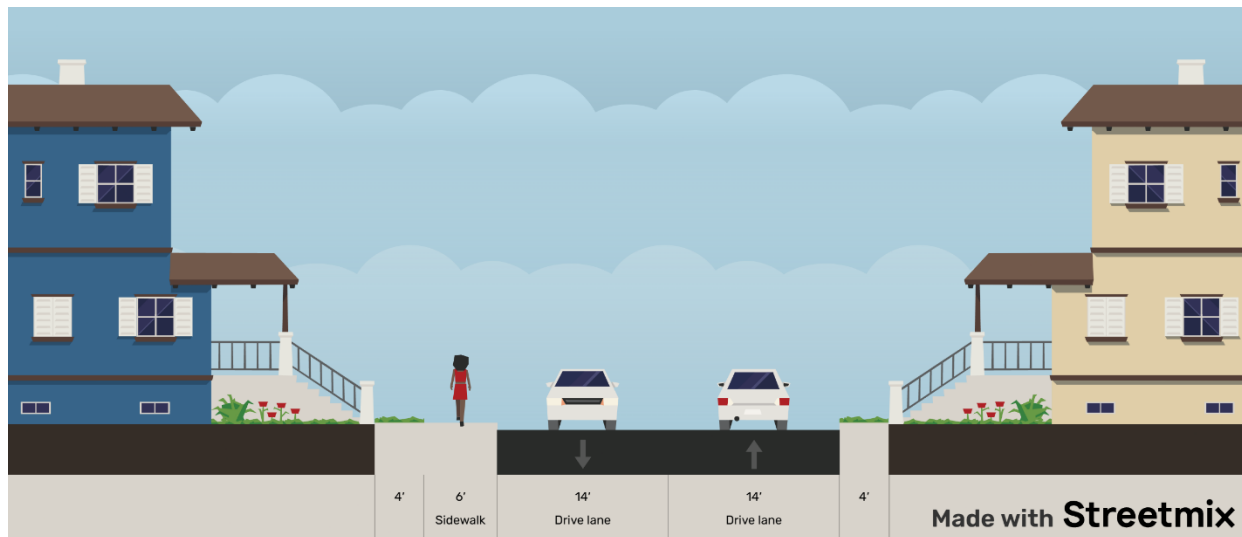


27TH ST TYPICAL SECTION

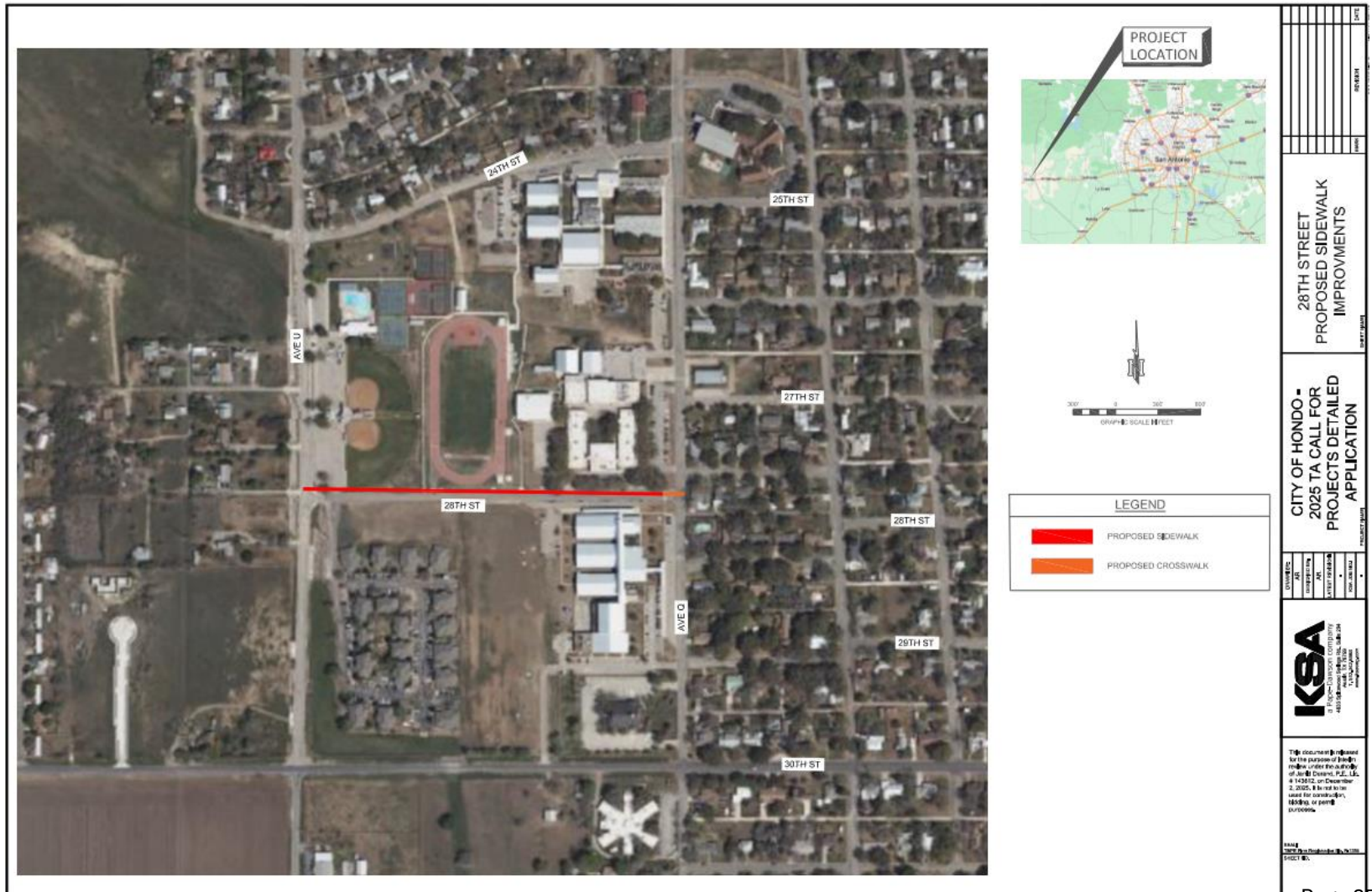
Existing 27th St

Avenue Q To Avenue E

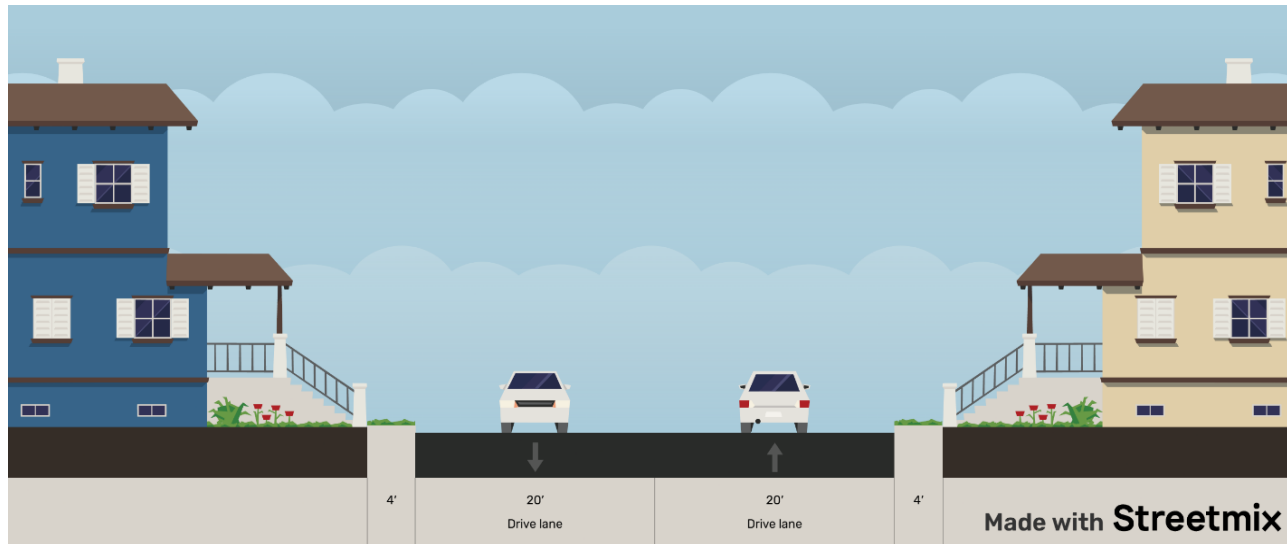


28TH ST PROPOSED SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

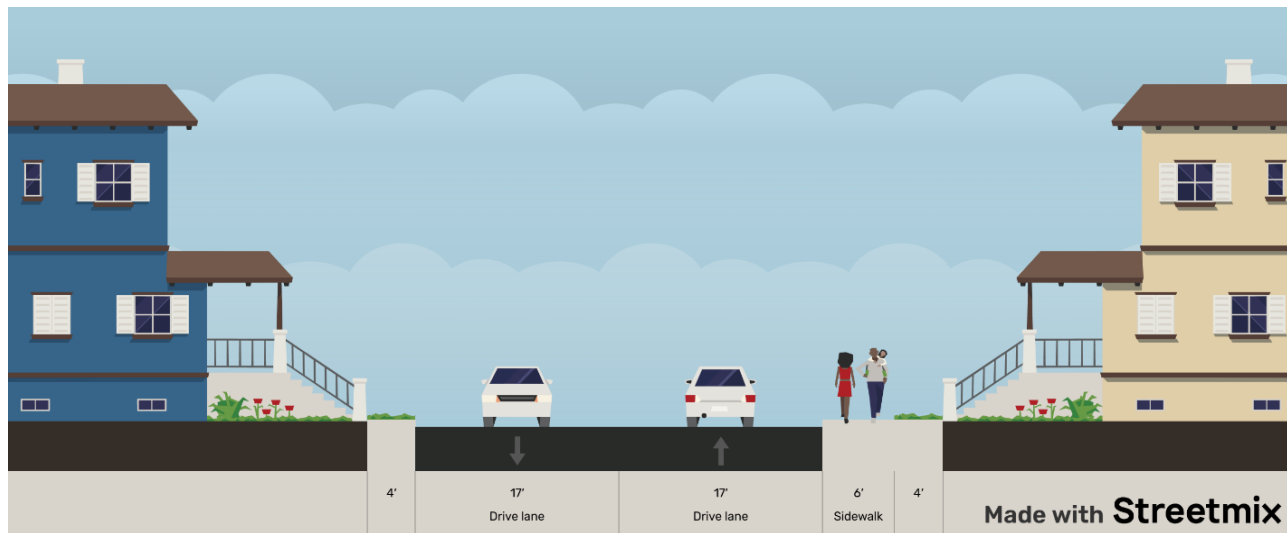


28TH ST TYPICAL SECTION

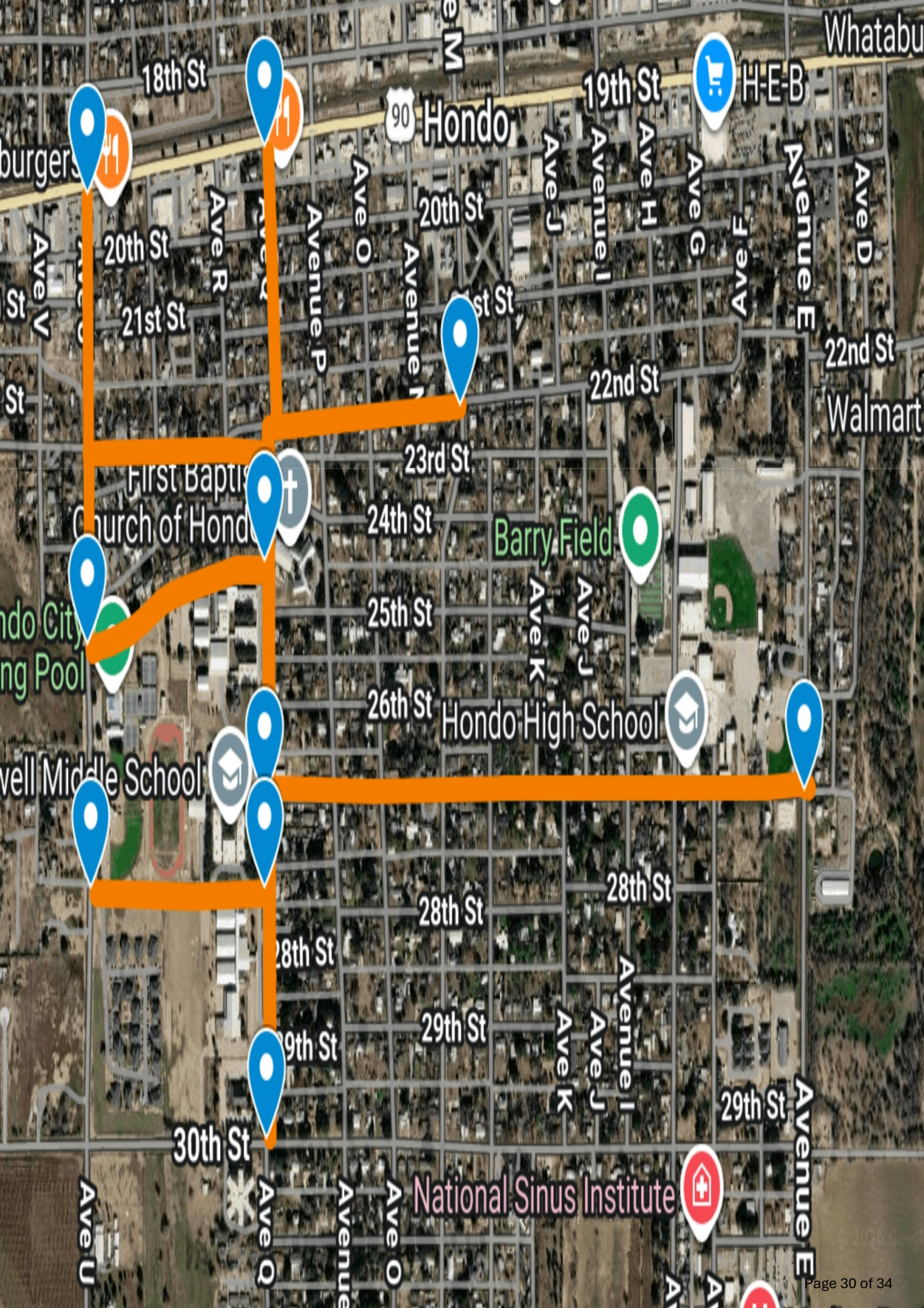

Sidewalk Improvements Descriptions

1. **Avenue U {24th ST To 19th St (Hwy 90)}**
 - Removing 6' of existing asphalt pavement and installing a 6' sidewalk on the east side of the street. Both existing travel lanes will be modified from approximately 20' to 17' wide to reduce vehicular travel speed
2. **Avenue Q {30th ST To Hwy 90 (19th St)}**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hondo finds that entering into an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for the Hondo 2025 Transportation Alternatives (TA) Sidewalk Improvements Project (CSJ 0915-45-064) is in the best interests of the City and desires to authorize the execution of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for the Hondo 2025 Transportation Alternatives (TA) Sidewalk Improvements Project (CSJ 0915-45-064), together with any related documents, certifications, amendments, or other instruments necessary or appropriate to carry out the City's obligations under the Agreement.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes and approves the City's financial participation in the Project as required by the Advance Funding Agreement, including:

- a) the required twenty percent (20%) local cash match;
- b) payment of all non-reimbursable project costs; and
- c) payment of one hundred percent (100%) of any project cost overruns or additional costs for which the City is responsible under the Advance Funding Agreement.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Development Services Department utilizes its assigned vehicle for daily field inspections, site visits, code enforcement, and other official City business. The current assigned vehicle, a 2016 Ford Taurus, has proven to be impractical for many of these duties due to its low ground clearance.

Staff frequently travels through alleys, construction sites, undeveloped properties, and other areas where the vehicle's low ride height limits accessibility and increases the potential for damage to the undercarriage. Replacing the current sedan with a vehicle that offers higher ground clearance will improve mobility, enhance safety, and better support the operational needs of the department.

Staff recommends authorizing the trade-in of the 2016 Ford Taurus and approving the purchase of a replacement vehicle that is better suited for Development Services field operations, subject to applicable purchasing policies and available budget.
